

Wisconsin rows upset win

Title caps 4-year pull

Randy Jablonic took a dip in Harsha Lake Saturday afternoon after the University of Wisconsin won the 1990 Herschede Cup — the Men's National Collegiate Rowing Championship.

Jablonic, coach of the Badgers for 22 years, was more than willing when his crew carried him off the bank and threw him in the lake for the traditional dunking of the coach.

"You can get me all wet any day of the week with a championship like this," he said.

The championship was the feature race in the Cincinnati Regatta at East Fork State Park.

This was Wisconsin's second victory in the men's varsity eight championship in
